INSTRUCTIONS

Events will occur rain or shine

Bring a Life Jacket (even if you don't bring your boat)

Bring a paddle or two and extra fenders – boats will be rafted at the docks

Bring your club's Burgee for the Burgee Parade (you'll get it back)

We hope to get EVERYONE out on a Scot during the "race" on Friday afternoon, so bring your deck shoes and a life jacket. Bring your camera, too.

Deep Creek Lake is located on a mountain (elevation 2400 ft) and will be 5 degrees cooler and much wetter than lower elevations. Be prepared for rain. Bring a rain jacket and warm clothes. Wear sturdy shoes. Parking at the Yacht Club is limited, so be prepared to walk on dark, uneven surfaces. Bring a flashlight. Banquet attire is "spiffy (not formal, not grungy) nautical".

DCYC Turkey Neck is located near Oakland, Maryland. The official address is 204 Yacht Club Rd, Swanton MD, 21561. The address of Flying Scot, Inc is 157 Cemetery St. Deer Park, MD 21550.

Driving Instructions:

From Deltaville: Take US 17 N to I-66. Take I-81 N to Winchester. Take US 50 W to junction with US 220, then N to Keyser, WV. Take MD 135 W to lake.

Warning: Mapquest sends you up the Allegheny Front on US 50...a very windy, difficult stretch of road that should be avoided.

From West: Take I-68 from Morgantown, WV to MD 42 S in Friendsville, MD.

Merge onto US 219 in Mc Henry, MD. Use Sand Flat Road to get to south end of lake.

From the NE: I-68 W to Grantsville, MD then MD 495 S to lake.
