## THIRD ANNUAL CALEDONIAN – JUNE 30 AND JULY 1, 2007 AT WILLOW BANK YACHT CLUB, CAZENOVIA, NY, with live entertainment by Dave Brubeck, Aretha Franklin, and Bella Fleck and the Flecktones

This open Flying Scot regatta will be hosted by Willow Bank Yacht Club, located on Cazenovia Lake, which is on US Route 20 about 20 miles southeast of Syracuse, NY. Willow Bank has a long racing history. The club has hosted the Empire Games, the Centrals, and numerous regattas with, in some cases, over 100 boats.

<u>Registration and sign-in</u> starts at 8:30 a.m. June 30. Skippers' meeting at 10. First race at 10:30. Five races on Saturday plus two on Sunday. Sunday first start at 9:30. On Saturday, no race will start after 4 pm. On Sunday, no race will start after 11:00 a.m.

We do it right. When you are rigged, our diesel tractor-driving yard boys will tow your boat to either hoist or ramp, and will then valet park your trailer while you do more important stuff. Dock space not a problem. When you come in, a yard boy will bring your trailer down to the water's edge.

<u>Camping at the club</u>: pitch your tent on mowed lawn, and enjoy a swim and/or a shower. Walking distance to downtown Cazenovia, which offers interesting shops, bars, etc.

After the regatta, you might want to view the 20 tower wind farm just east of Cazenovia. If there is sufficient advance nterest by the group, we'll try to have a guide available Sunday afternoon to explain the project. That's the only way you get to stand at the base of one of the wind generators, and this is an awesome experience. There is a major and first class automobile museum in Norwich, NY. Cazenovia is also home to Lorenzo, an early 19<sup>th</sup> century mansion now operated by New York State.

Entertainment This is also the weekend of the (<u>free admission</u>) <u>Syracuse Jazz Fest</u>, so for anyone who wants to fight the crowds, there will be first-rate entertainment Friday, Saturday, and Sunday night in Syracuse. [Friday at 9:30 p.m.: *Bela Fleck and the Flecktones*.] [Saturday at 9:00 p.m.: *Dave Brubeck*,] and fireworks at 10. [Sunday at 8:00 p.m. *Aretha Franklin*.] For more details, check <u>www.syracusejazzfest.com</u>. Bela Fleck is outstanding, but then so are the others. Again, <u>no</u> admission charge but there will be crowds.

## Directions to Willow Bank Yacht Club

<u>From the west</u>, take Thruway exit 34A, onto Interstate 481 south to Exit 3 (second exit ramp) – signs will mention Fayetteville, Route 5 east. This exit will put you onto Routes 5 and 92 combined, but in a mile they split and you stay on Route 92 through Manlius to Route 20 at a T intersection at the southwest corner of Cazenovia Lake. Turn left on Route 20, then left at the first light (another T intersection), straight at the second light (onto Forman Street). The club is a few driveways up, on the left. Camp and rig your boat on the lawn next to the parking area.

From the east, take Thruway exit 34 (Canastota). From the exit ramp, turn left, onto Route 13 (South). Stay on Route 13 which joins with Route 5 on the south side of Canastota, and then stay on Route 13 (South) when these two roads separate on the far side of Chittenango. Route 13 will take you right past Chittenango Falls State Park, and if you have time, this is worth a stop. You can see the falls in a 15 minute visit. In Cazenovia, Route 13 merges with Route 20. After you pass through the business district, you'll come to a T intersection where you must turn right or left. Turn right, onto Forman Street. The club is a few driveways up, on the left. Camp and rig your boat on the lawn next to the parking area.

From the south, two ways. From Interstate 81, take the Lafayette exit and Route 20 east to Cazenovia, where Route 13 joins Route 20, OR to avoid big hills, if you have a low powered car, take Route 13 from Cortland. After Routes 13 and 20 join (at a light), continue, and at the next light, go straight where these routes go right. This puts you on Forman Street. The club is a few driveways up, on the left. Camp and rig your boat on the lawn next to the parking area.
